

How do I do an Instant Record?

Note: Instant Recording is a quick way to record the channel you are currently viewing. If you have Time Shifting enabled, you can even move the starting point back.

1. Switch on the Beyonwiz PVR and wait for a picture to show on the screen. If a picture doesn't appear, your PVR may need to scan your channels first – See "How do I do a Channel Scan?"
2. Press the **REC** button on the remote
3. Use the **ARROW** keys on the remote to increase / decrease the **Duration**
4. Use the **ARROW** keys on the remote to navigate down to **Starting Point**, then use the **ARROW** keys to move the **Starting Point** to record **Live** or **Current Program** or **All**

Live	Starts from the time you pressed REC
Current Program	Records the Current Program (from where it starts in the Time Shift buffer)
All	Record everything in the Time Shift buffer

5. Use the **ARROW** keys on the remote to navigate down to **File Name** and if you want to change it, press the **OK** button.
6. Use the **ARROW** keys to highlight a **letter**, then the **OK** button to enter it. The letter should appear on the top line. Continue this process to create the file name.

When you've finished entering the new file name use the **ARROW** keys to highlight **Save and Exit** and press **OK**.

*Note: You can switch **Caps Lock** on and off using the **RED** button. The **Circle Arrow** button is **Backspace***

7. Use the **ARROW** keys on the remote to navigate down to **Accept** and press the **OK** button.
8. To **Pause, Stop** or **Resume** a recording, press the **REC** button on the remote, then press the **PAUSE** button to Pause / Resume and the **STOP** button to stop the recording.
