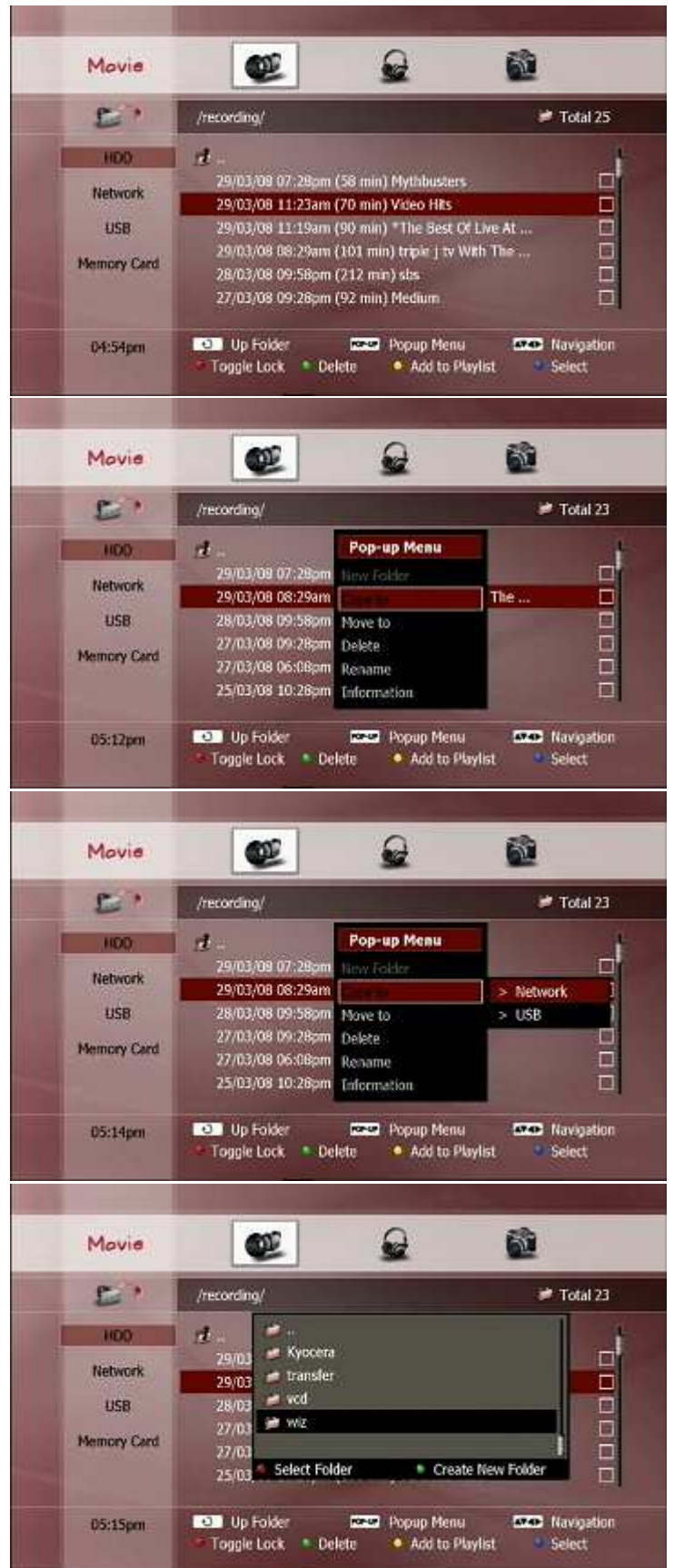


How do I copy a recorded file to my PC?

Note: Once you have recorded a number of TV shows, you may want to copy some to a network share to free up space on the internal HDD. This tutorial assumes you already have some recorded files on the HDD.

1. Switch on the Beyonwiz PVR and wait for a picture to show on the screen. If a picture doesn't appear, your PVR may need to scan your channels first – See "How do I do a Channel Scan?"
2. Press the **FILE PLAY** button (next to **LIVE**) on the remote to bring up the **Media Player**.
3. Press the **◀▶ ARROW** keys to move to **Movie** (listed top left)
4. Press the **▲▼ ARROW** keys to move to **HDD** and press **OK**.
5. Press **OK** to open the **recording** folder.
6. Use the **▲▼ ARROW** keys to highlight a file you want to rename and press the **POP-UP** button on the remote.
7. Use the **▲▼ ARROW** keys to highlight **Copy To** then use the **◀▶ ARROW** keys to highlight **Yes** to the **Check File Size** warning.
8. Use the **ARROW** keys to highlight **> Network** and press **OK**
9. Use the **ARROW** keys to highlight your File Server, then share and press the **RED** button.

The copy should begin and you will see a progress indicator.



Note: You can also copy to a USB drive.

*It is fine to press the **LIVE** button and resume normal viewing while the copy is in progress.*
